The Stone of Destiny is a 335 lb. block of red sandstone that was used for centuries in the coronation of Scottish monarchs. In 1296, King Edward I of England captured it as a spoil of war and brought it to Westminster Abbey in London. For the last 700 years, it has been used in the coronation of the queens and kings of England and Great Britain. In 1996, the British government, in a spirit of reconciliation, returned the Stone of Destiny to Scotland. It now resides in Edinburgh Castle.
